Brief introduction of the University

Mata Gujri University, Kishanganj, has been established on 20-02-2019 under the aegis of Mata Gujri Memorial Medical College & Lions Seva Kendra Hospital Trust, Kishanganj, Bihar (sponsoring body) vide Government of Bihar Notification No- 15/M-1-164/2015-463 dated 20-02-2019, published in Bihar Government Gazette no. 267 dated 22 February 2019 under the provisions of the Bihar Private Universities Act 2013, with a vision to promote creativity, innovation and research that solves the education and healthcare issues of the present and the future scenario of the State and also to strive to provide Excellence in Education including Technical and Professional Education and Health Care Sector.

The University is located in Kishanganj District, in the State of Bihar. Kishanganj District of Bihar, is socially, educationally and economically one of the most backward districts of the state.

The Campus of the University is spread over more than 50 Acres Land. The first constituent unit of University i.e. Mata Gujri Memorial Medical College, Kishanganj was established in 1990.

- Good Hostel & residential facilities are available,
- Specialised Medical facility with qualified doctors available,
- Modern Gymnasium, Library with sufficient books, prints & e-journals are available,
- Lecture Theatres, Class rooms, Auditorium, Safe drinking water, 24 hours electric supply, security guards etc are available,
- · Sports and cultural facility are available,
- · Facility for access by differently abled students & staff is available,
- Fire fighting arrangements are available in all buildings.

B. Suggestion of the Committee which require satisfactory compliance by the University

- IQAC needs to be constituted and notified as per the requirement of the University,
- Medical Research Unit needs to be constituted to promote research activities,
- Clinical Society to be formed and its regular clinical research meetings to be conducted,
- NSS and NCC activities be initiated,
- Intramural and extramural funding may be initiated.

C. Final Recommendations

The Committee as mentioned above, visited various facilities in the University campus dealing with Medical courses during our two days' visit i.e. 20th and 21st January, 2020.

The committee examined the physical infrastructure, central facilities and the facilities like academic, patient care research and administrative units related to the areas as mentioned. The committee also took stock of relevant documents submitted before the committee by the authority, with regard to the university governance, academic programs, student admission, patient care facilities examination system, administrative set up and other related matters of interest. The committee also took inputs during interaction from Faculty, Students and Non-teaching staff, and Management officials including Vice Chancellor and Chancellor.

In view of the above, the Committee unanimously recommends granting approval to the Mata Gujri University, Kishanganj, Bihar subject to compliance of the suggestions as in Part- IV (B) on pre-page.
