

#### 5. ACADEMIC STRUCTURE

#### 5.1 ADMISSION PROCESS

- An applicant for admission to a programme must apply in the prescribed Application Form (copy appended with the Prospectus) following the Advertisement in the newspapers to the Admission Counsellor of the University within the deadline.
- The application for admission to the programme will be verified by the Admission Counsellor followed by the authentication of the concerned School Principal, and Dean (UG/ PG)
- The selection for admission will be done in order of merit and, if necessary, based on the success in the Admission / Entrance Test; and subject to verification of original transcripts / certificates.
- There are certain programmes in which admission eligibility will depend on the pass percentage marks of the qualifying Examination/Test.
- For admission in any programme, the candidate must have to submit the Transfer Certificate / Migration.
- M.Phil. & Ph.D. programmes are also available.

#### 5.2 EXAMINATION BYELAWS

- The University follows the 10-point Grading System of evaluation from 2017-18 session.
- The University intends to adopt semester/ annual system allowing the continuous monitoring and evaluation of performance of the students which includes two internal midterm and University level end semester examinations.
- For appearing at the end semester (University) Examinations, a student has to qualify the internal examinations with the class attendance ensured as per the School regulation.
- The weightage given to the University internal and end semester examinations is 30% and 70 % respectively.
- The Academic Calendar of the University explains Examination related deadlines and full details.

#### 6. LIBRARY

- The University has Central Library consisting of about ten thousand books and journals/ periodicals from different fields.
- ❖ The library has sufficient study space with Delineated internet facilities. The library remains open during the office hours.

E-Library, NPTEL and Video Library are available.

# 7. COMPUTER CENTRE & CENTRAL COMPUTING FACILITY (CCF)

- The University has a Computer Centre as a central computing facility (CCF) for the students, research scholars and the teachers of the University.
- The Centre has necessary infrastructure like sufficient number of Computer Hardware and Software, air-conditioned space and stabilized uninterrupted back-up power supply as well as trained technical manpower.

# 10.2 ADMISSION ONLINE AT KKU, NALANDA

Online submission of application forms for admission in the regular Post Graduate, Under Graduate, Diploma and Certificate Programmes / Courses shall begin on April 20, 2018 and continue until June 15, 2018. The appearing candidates may apply for admission in such Programmes / Courses where admission is based on Entrance test but they must submit the copy of marks sheet of all the previous result before the finalization of selection list for admission failing which their candidature will not be considered for admission. Marks sheet is mandatory in such Programmes / Courses where admission is based on the marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination.
