





ABOUT HOLY MATH



Shri Baba Mastnath Math is the oldest and the most religious place of Nath Sect belonging to Kanpada Yogies. This is the main Taposthali (place of worship) of Nath Yogies and is situated on the outskirts of Rohtak city, near Tilyar Tourist Complex, on Delhi-Rohtak NH- 10. The Math has been the repository and centre for pursuit of Indian civilization and has been doing yeo-men service for the benefit of mankind. To fulfil the statutory requirements and for effective and efficient management of Educational and Non-Educational Institutions/Organizations, the Math formed a Trust in 1980 in the name of SHRI BABA MASTNATH AYURVED AND SANSKRIT SHIKSHAN SANSTHAN.

परिचय ब्रह्मलीन महंत चाँदनाथ जी योगी

Founder Chancellor, BMU

'सद्गुरु की महिमा अनत, अनत किया उपकार। लोचन अनत उघाड़िया, अनत दिखावणहार।।'

योगी चाँदनाथ जी सच्चे संत और अच्छे सद्गुरु थे। वे ज्ञान के पुंज थे। इतना ही नहीं, वे अलौकिक संत, महान कर्मयोगी, महान तपस्वी और समाजसेवी थे। योगी चाँदनाथ का जन्म वर्ष 21 जून, 1956 को दिल्ली के बेगमपुर गाँव के साधारण किसान परिवार में हुआ था। उनके पिता का नाम श्री मोहर सिंह व माता का नाम श्रीमती चम्पा देवी था। वे सात भाई-बहनों में सबसे बड़े थे तथा बचपन से ही कुशाग्रबुद्धि और आध्यात्मिक विचारों के थे। घर-गृहस्थी से अलग होकर वे साधना कर्म में संलग्न रहते थे।

योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने वर्ष 1977 में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय से बी. ए. ऑनर्स की उपिध प्राप्त की तथा वर्ष 1978 में वे शिक्षा, धर्म व अध्यात्म के केन्द्र अस्थल बोहर मठ के महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी को अपना गुरु बनाकर शिष्य परम्परा का निर्वहण किया। महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी उन दिनों किसी योग्य उत्तराधिकारी की तलाश में थे। उनकी यह तलाश योगी चाँदनाथ को शिष्य रूप में पाकर पूर्ण हो गई और महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ को इनमें अस्थल बोहर मठ का भविष्य नजर आने लगा। फलत: शिष्य की प्रशासनिक कार्य क्षमता परखने के लिए हनुमानगढ़ मठ के कोठारी का उत्तरदायित्व उन्हें सौंपा। हनुमानगढ़ में जनता की स्वास्थ्य सम्बन्धी परेशानियों को देखते हुए नेत्र चिकित्सालय, सामान्य चिकित्सालय, एक शिव मन्दिर का निर्माण करवाकर जनसेवक एवं धर्मसेवक होने का परिचय दिया। योगी चाँदनाथ की कार्यक्षमता, कार्यशैली दोनों ही महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी को अच्छी लगी और उन्होंने मन में विचार किया कि मठ की समृद्धि के लिए जीवित रहते किसी योग्य उत्तराधिकारी का चयन आवश्यक है। वर्ष 1984 में महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ ने योगी चाँदनाथ को अस्थल बोहर मठ का उत्तराधिकारी घोषित किया। वर्ष 1985 में महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ के समाधिलीन होने पर महंत के रूप में योगी महंत चाँदनाथ ने मठ के विकास कार्यों को गित प्रदान की। महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने 'विधेयं जन सेवनं' के मार्ग का अनुसरण करते हुए धर्म, शिक्षा, चिकित्सा को अपना कर्म क्षेत्र बनाया। वर्ष 1986 में उन्होंने एक विद्यालय से इसकी शुरुआत की तथा वर्ष 2012 में अपने संस्थान को विश्वविद्यालय का दर्जा दिलवाया जो विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त है।

वर्ष 1986 में अपने गुरुजी महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी की समाधि स्थल का निर्माण, वर्ष 1987 में सिविल रोड, रोहतक में पब्लिक स्कूल की स्थापना, वर्ष 1988 में अस्थल बोहर, मट में अवासीय पब्लिक स्कूल की स्थापना, वर्ष 1989 में बाबा मस्तनाथ सभागार का निर्माण, वर्ष 1990 में शिव मन्दिर की स्थापना, वर्ष 1991 में प्राचीन शिवमन्दिर का जीणोंद्धार, वर्ष 1992 में थेहड़ी डेरे के मन्दिर का निर्माण, वर्ष 1993 चक 7 एल. एल. का निर्माण, वर्ष 1994 में श्री बद्रीनाथ धर्मशाला का निर्माण, वर्ष 1995 में एम.बी.ए. कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1996 में फार्मेसी एवं डी.एड. कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1997 में डेंटल एवं इंजिनियरिंग कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1998 में फिजियोथेरेपी एवं मॉडर्न साइंसेज कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1999 में संस्कृत महाविद्यालय की स्थापना, वर्ष 2000 में नर्सिंग कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 2001 में कन्या छात्रावास का निर्माण कराया।

इसी वर्ष महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी योगी को उनके विशेष कार्यों के लिए इन्दिरा गाँधी अवार्ड से सम्मानित किया गया। वर्ष 2002 में श्री रणपतमानधाता जी की समाधि स्थल का निर्माण, वर्ष 2003 में रैबारी धर्मशाला का निर्माण। वर्ष 2004 में महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी महाराज को राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा 'शिक्षा रत्न' से सम्मानित किया गया तथा इसी वर्ष महंत चाँदनाथ योगी बहरोड़ विधानसभा क्षेत्र से विधायक बने और अपने कार्यकौशल से वहाँ की व्यवस्थाओं को दुरुस्त कर कायाकल्प किया। वर्ष 2005 में चिकित्सा भवन तथा छात्रावास-2 का निर्माण, वर्ष 2006 में बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज की विशाल प्रतिमा का निर्माण। वर्ष 2007 में महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी को राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा राजस्थान गौरव अवार्ड से सम्मानित किया गया। वर्ष 2008 में बी. एड. महाविद्यालयों की, अस्थल बोहर, रोहतक, हरियाणा एवं हनुमानगढ़, राजस्थान में स्थापना, वर्ष 2009 में एम. टेक, एम. फार्मा, कोर्सो का प्रारम्भ, वर्ष 2010 में सिद्ध शिरोमणि बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज के समाधि मन्दिर की नींव रखी गई एवं एम.सी.ए. व सिविल इंजिनियरिंग के कोर्स प्रारम्भ किये गये। वर्ष 2011 में बाबा मस्तनाथ पॉलिटेक्निक संस्थान की स्थापना, वर्ष 2012 में बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय की स्थापना, वर्ष 2016 में 5 वर्षीय एम.बी.ए. तथा बी. एससी. केमिस्टी ऑनर्स के कार्स प्रारम्भ हए।

वर्ष 2016 में अपनी दूरदर्शिता का परिचय देते हुए अपने अनेक शिष्यों में से कर्मठ, ईमानदार, योग्य एवं अनुभवी शिष्य बालक नाथ जी योगी को मठ का उत्तराधिकारी बनाया।

यदि विकास की दृष्टि से अवलोकन किया जाए तो इस मठ में निर्माण में कार्य कभी बन्द होता ही नहीं है। वर्तमान समय में भी लगभग 150 करोड़ रुपये की लागत से अक्षरधाम मन्दिर की तर्ज पर एक भव्य मन्दिर का निर्माण कार्य चल रहा है, जो अपने आप में अनूठा समाधि स्थल और भव्य मन्दिर होगा।

महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी दिव्य एवं अलौकिक संत थे जो जन्म व मृत्यु के रहस्य को भी भलीभाँति जानते थे, परन्तु विधि के विधान को कौन टाल सकता है जिसने इस नश्वर शरीर को धारण किया है, हर किसी को उस परमतत्त्व में विलीन होना पड़ता है। इस कालक्रम के प्रवाह में वर्ष 2015 में परमपूज्य महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी महाराज को एक भयावह बीमारी ने घेर लिया, जिसके चलते 7 सितंबर, 2017 चैत्र सुदी द्वादशी को वे ब्रह्मलीन हो गए।

महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने स्वयं के लिए कभी नहीं सोचा, अपितु शिक्षा के माध्यम से वे लाखों लोगों की सेवा करने के लिए वे हमेशा कार्यरत रहे। वास्तव में, वे सच्चे शिक्षाविद और प्रेरणा स्रोत रहे। उन्होंने अपना जीवन जरूरतमन्दों की सेवा एवं उनके उत्थान में लगाया। वे एक सच्चे कर्मयोगी थे। वास्तव में उनके जीवन से लाखों लोगों को प्रेरणा मिलती रहेगी। भले ही वे आज हमारे बीच पार्थिव रूप में नहीं हैं, परन्तु प्रेरणा–स्वरूप वे हमारे साथ हमेशा विद्यमान रहेंगे।

वैसे भी सन्तों का अपना कुछ नहीं होता है, वे तो केवल मात्र समाज के उत्थान के लिए जन्म लेते हैं एवं समाज की भलाई के लिए मर-मिटते हैं। विश्वविद्यालय के कुलाधिपित होने के नाते मेरी यही कामना है कि विश्वविद्यालय का हर व्यक्ति अपने काम में पूरी निष्ठा और प्रतिबद्धता से जुट जाए। विद्यार्थी पढ़ने में, शिक्षक पढ़ाने में, कर्मचारी एवं अधिकारी अपने कर्त्तव्य को ठीक से निर्वाह करने में लग जायें, फिर देखना वह दिन दूर नहीं होगा, जिस दिन यह विश्वविद्यालय अपने सपनों का, लोगों के सपनों का विश्वविद्यालय होगा। मैं अपने सभी शिक्षकों एवं अधिकारियों का आह्वान करता हूँ कि वे अच्छे अध्यापन, गुणवत्तापरक अनुसंधान, रोजगारोन्मुखी पाठ्यचर्या, मूल्योन्मुखी शिक्षा पर अधिक बल दें, जिससे विश्वविद्यालय को श्रेष्ठ शिक्षा संस्थान की पंक्ति में खड़ा किया जा सके। मैं सत्र 2021-2022 में सभी प्रवेशार्थी विद्यार्थियों का बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय में आगमन पर शुभाशीष देता हूँ। अन्त में हमारी मंगल कामना है कि—







ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. The Information Brochure will be available at the Counter on payment of Rs. 1000. The candidate can also download the Admission Form from the website "www.bmu.ac.in". Such candidates will submit the Admission Form along with the Bank Draft of Rs. 1000 in favour of Baba Mastnath University, Asthal Bohar, Rohtak. The Admission Form completed in all respect may be submitted in the concerned Deptt./ Faculty. However, the students can also apply online as per instructions through university website 'www.bmu.ac.in.'
- 2. The admissions in the University shall be made on Academic Merit or the merit in the Entrance Test conducted by an Agency of the State



Government or the Association of Private Universities.

- 3. The candidates should remain in touch for the Entrance Test to be conducted as per the guidelines of the State Government.
- 4. In case sufficient applications are not received in a Course, the applicant(s) will be given option to change to any other Course in the University, subject to the eligibility and merit or for refund of fee.
- 5. A minimum of 25% seats for admissions are reserved for students of the State of Haryana, out of which 10% seats shall be reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Castes of the State of Haryana.
- The Fee Concession for 25% of the students who are residents of Haryana will be as per the approved policy.
- 7. All admissions are provisional subject to verification of documents and approval by the Competent Authorities.
- 8. The outlines of courses have been made available on the University Website.

SCHEDULE OF FEE PAYMENT

- 1. The fee will be charged in two Instalments. First Instalment will be paid by the students at the time of admission and second Instalment by 31st January. Students who fail to deposit second instalment by 31st January, will be charged late fee as per the schedule to be notified separately. For old Students, the schedule of payment of fee (without late fee/with late fee) will also be notified separately.
- 2. One time Processing Fee will be charged extra at the time of admission as under:

The Examination Fee, Red Cross Fee (Rs. 80), Magazine Subscription (Rs. 250) and Hostel Charges will also be charged extra. No Processing fee is being charged from the students of Shastri/M.A. Sanskrit.

3. In case a student remains absent from the class continuously upto 7 days, he/she will be charged a fine of Rs. 500. Beyond 7 days, his/her name will be struck off and re-admission may be allowed on payment of fine of Rs. 1,500 within 15 days. If he/she remains absent after 15 days, re-admission will be allowed on payment of the Rs. 2,000 with prior approval of Vice Chancellor, provided that the student is likely to complete the required number of lectures, to be eligible, to appear in the examination.

REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

All requests for cancellation / withdrawal of admission must be made in writing well in time on the prescribed format available from the Registrar Office along with the original Fee Receipt.

In case, a student withdraws his/her admission within 7 days after last date of admission without late fee, i.e 30-09-2021 the fee deposited by him/her shall be refunded after deducting Processing Fee. No refund will be admissible in case the candidate applies after the prescribed period of seven days i.e. 07-10-2021.

The students who are admitted with late fee will not be entitled for any refund of fee.

HOSTEL RULES

- a) Hostel door will be opened in the morning at 5.00 AM and closed at night at 10.00 PM. Before and after this time, permission will be taken from the Hostel Warden to stay away.
- b) All hostlers should seek prior permission of Hostel Warden for going home or to relative's / guardian's house.
- c) Use of alcohol and intoxicants of any nature are strictly prohibited. If any student is found guilty, strict disciplinary action including fine or cancellation of admission will be taken.
- d) Students are advised not to keep excessive cash or valuables with them in the hostel.
- e) Students leaving for home must obtain the Outward Pass duly authorized by Warden, and get it signed from their parents, which will be checked on their return.

LIMITED LIABILITY

All admissions made by the Admission Committee are provisional and subject to confirmation by the University. If the admission of any candidate(s) is not confirmed by the University, for any reason whatsoever, liability of the University will be limited only to the refund of full fee Paid by the candidate and that there shall be no further consequential liability on the University and / or any of its employee(s).

In case a candidate seeks admission by producing any forged document or fraudulently, his admission shall be cancelled forthwith and fee will be confiscated. Further legal action will be taken against him/her as per rules.

ANTI-RAGGING DRIVE & ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Ragging in any from is strictly prohibited in accordance and as per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
STUDENTS FOUND INDULGING IN ANY KIND OF RAGGING SHALL BE OUTRIGHTLY RUSTICATED FROM THE UNIVERSITY
AND LEGAL ACTION AS PRESCRIBED MAY BE INITIATED. Students shall be subject to Regulations of UGC dated 17th June, 2009 as, amended from time to time.

Disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student(s), indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in fresher or junior student(s) or asking the student(s) to do any act or perform something, which such student(s) will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of fresher or a junior student shall constitute an act of ragging.

Association, active or passive, with any unlawful organization including holding and/or participating in demonstrations, inciting violence, displaying notices or circulating handbills in the University and/ or its hostel (s)/ mess are strictly prohibited.

Smoking, consumption of alcohol, drugs or any other intoxicant by whatsoever name called within the University premises and/or its Hostel(s) is strictly prohibited.

Any student carrying a fire arm or any dangerous weapon in and around the University premises and / or its hostel(s) shall be suspended forthwith and expelled from the University.

Besides police/legal action, a student found indulging in any of the above activities shall be expelled from the University. In case of expulsion from the University, under such circumstances, the student's tuition, development and / or any other fee paid by him/her shall stand forfeited.

IMPORTANT RULES & REGULATIONS

(All the students are strictly advised to read/understand the Regulations/Rules of the University)

- Students are not expected to indulge in any unsocial, criminal or political activity, not conforming to his status as a student and against the interest of the University.
- 2. student found damaging the University property shall be punished & fined and may also be suspended/rusticated from the University and amount of loss incurred shall be recovered from the student, (individual or in group as the case be).
- 3. Consumption of tobacco products, alcohol, chewing of gutka, inside the Campus/Hostels is strictly prohibited. Students found consuming these items are liable to be fined and punished. They may even be rusticated.
- 4. Students shall follow the prescribed Dress Code in the University, Defaulter students would invite suitable fines and will not be allowed to attend the Classes.
- 5. Students shall be provided with IDENTITY CARD. Students are required to wear it always and produce it as and when asked for Duplicate cards will be available on payment of Rs. 200/-or as decided time to time.
- 6. Gadgets like Mobile Phones, Walkman, Radio, etc. are not allowed inside the classrooms, workshops, seminars, etc. Usage of above will lead to seizure of these gadgets and the same would be released only after payment of fine.
- 7. Usage of facilities (Bus/Hostel) and infrastructure viz. Library, Computer Lab, Workshop etc. are governed separately, Respective rules shall be notified from time to time, and shall be binding on Students.
- 8. In case the student withdraws from the Hostel/Transportation facility, he/she must inform to the Dean Offce in writing, well in advance, before the commencement of session. Otherwise the charges shall continue to be levied.
- 9. Any changes in contact number or address should be informed immediately to the concerned Dean and the Registrar's Office. Defaulting on it, may cause difficulties in contacting in case of any emergency.
- 10. Cases of indiscipline shall be dealt with as per the Regulations for Maintenance of Discipline among students. Cases of indiscipline shall be reported to the Disciplinary Committee and in such cases the decision of the Disciplinary Committee shall be final and binding on the Student and parents.

Jurisdiction

Disputes, if any, arising out of this Admission Policy & Selection Procedure shall be the subject matter of Rohtak courts only.

CAMPUS RULES

- Students are required to be punctual for their classes as well as for seminars, presentation and assessment test.
- 2. Minimum 75% Attendance is compulsory to appear in the University Examination. Students have to submit leave application giving valid reasons for absence from the classes, to the concerned Dean.
- 3. Absence from classes for more then 15 days without prior information shall lead to cancellation of the admission of the student and would attract re-admission charges, as may be decided on case to case basis and no fees will be refunded.
- 4. In case of any document found to be fake or even if the university gives the enrollment due to false documents, the admission will be cancelled with immediate effect and no fees will be refunded.
- 5. Information regarding examinations, activities etc. shall be displayed on the Notice Boards and shall not be communicated to the students individually. It is the student's responsibility to remain vigilant and visit the University Website/read notice board.
- The request for Change of Branch Stream shall be processed as per the guidelines of the University.
- 7. For using any unauthorized gadget/equipment like Heater, Iron, etc. applicable electricity charges shall be deposited by the Hosteller and any outstanding bill amount shall be paid within one month from the due date of bill payment. Otherwise, late fees shall be applicable as per Hostel Rules.
- 8. The terms & conditions, rules & regulations and other details shall be amended by the University and shall be available for the students on website (www.bmu.ac.in) of the university.

FACILITIES AT THE CAMPUS

Hostel

We have separate hostel for boys and girls accommodating capacity of 500 boys and 200 girls. Single room accommodation is given to the final year and PG students. They are also permitted to use their computers in their own rooms. The mess is spacious with a dining hall and kitchen. Separate seating arrangements are made for boys and girls. Visitors are allowed on holidays from 11.00 A.M. to 6.00 P.M.

Library

The University Library functions as General and Departmental Libraries. The General Library block has three floors. Ground floor is the OERC (Online Education Research Centre). First floor is the Stack Room and Computer Area. Second floor is the Reading Room and EDUSAT Centre. The College Library has a good collection of about 148000 books. The General Library subscribes 40 Periodicals and 11 Newspapers. The Library has a special collection of books for NET Exams on all subjects.

Sports

The Sports Department in the University has been established to promote the spirit of Sports participation amongst the students. The Department annually organizes the various activities from time to time as per the calendar to be circulated by the Director of sports. The University also participates in different Inter-Varsity games. The Sports Department of the University is visualizing programs to increase participation of students in different sports activities by offering financial incentives to the medal winners in different Inter-Varsity sports tournaments. The University every year honors students who have scored more than 75% marks in addition to winning a medal in AIU sponsored All India or North-Zone sports or Youth Festival competitions.

NCC

The University has two NCC Units, one for Boys & one for Girls. The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a youth development movement. It has enormous potential for nation building. The NCC provides opportunities to the youth of the country for their all-round development with a sense of Duty, Commitment, Dedication, Discipline and Moral Values so that they become able leaders and useful citizens. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps. CDS written exam exemption is given to NCC cadets for SSC recruitment. Special preference is given to NCC cadets at several central and state Government organizations.









Auditorium

The University has 2 Auditoriums both are fully functional, Centrally Air Conditioned with a seating capacity of more than 1600 persons. The auditoriums have a state of the art audio-visual system and a multifunctional lighting arrangement. The sound proof auditoriums host numerous events including cultural programmes, lectures and college annual function. All the major functions, assembly and various competitions are held in these auditoriums

Cafeteria

The Campus has canteen facilities which serve tea, coffee, juice, beverages and healthy snacks. These are hubs of general togetherness where students flock for relaxing and refreshing needs. The management is fully committed to keeping the quality of the canteen for the utmost benefit of all concerned, it has been stated. It is a matter of public interest and will be dealt with in due course. These cater to the sundry and day to day living needs, takeaway needs, dry cleaning, ironing, etc.

Bank/ATM

At BMU, we provide the best banking facilities to our students. To cater to their banking needs, we have on campus fully airconditioned and fully computerized branches of Canara, ICICI, Punjab National Bank which is based on the CBS platform. To meet the daily requirements of cash, we have ATMS, Post office in Campus. A leading employee can open a personal bank account with minimum effort. The personnel at the branch are extremely student-friendly, and they assist junior members with any questions they may have regarding banking in general. Students can also use their accounts at other banks to do business.

NSS

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a programme organized by the Ministry of Education and Youth Services of the Government of India to offer opportunities and training in service to the community and the nation for students with an aptitude. It is intended to involve the college students in a variety of social services and developmental activities concomitantly with the normal academic programme. The motto of the scheme is "Education through Community Service" Students of the first and second year Degree classes are eligible for admission. A total of 300 students will be enrolled in our university units which will be under the control of Programme Officers.





















Eye Hospital

The hospital has pioneering technology and a highly experienced team of doctors who aim at quick and best recovery of our patients to the people of Northern India. Every year 1, 00,000 patients are being treated free of cost. The hospital is having state-of-art gadgets and pieces of equipment. The bed occupancy of the hospital is nearly 60. We offer Glaucoma Diagnostic Surgery, Eye Ultrasound, Squint Surgery, Cornea Diagnostic & Surgery, Retina and Vitreous Diagnostics, Paediatric Ophthalmology, and comprehensive eye examination to our patients.

General Hospital

Under the aegis of Baba Mastnath Math, the hospital has been serving the needs of students, staff and the surrounding community for more than five decades. Implantology, Invisible Braces, Laser Dentistry (painless soft tissue therapy), Paediatric Dentistry, and a painless root canal treatment are all available at Dentistry.

Physiotherapy Hospital

The University has a Physiotherapy Hospital also, having the facilities for treatment of all types of pains, disabilities and Injuries like sports injury, musculoskeletal injuries, nerve related Injuries like hemiplegia, diplegia, quadriplegia and nerve damage, birth related anomalies etc.. 


