Establishment and Recognition Status




Introduction

The application to seek scholarship shall only be considered, if a candidate ensures that all dues and required documents are submitted at the time of seeking scholarship.

Scholarship once awarded shall continue for all the semesters of the programme, but limited to minimum duration of the programme. However, this will be discontinued due to non compliance of maintaining CGPA of 7 or higher / Minimum Attendance of 85% / Disciplinary and other conditions as per the Scholarship Policy.

Migration policy

- Students are allowed to migrate from Indus International University to other universities and from other universities to Indus International University as per provisions made in University Academic Regulations.
- Migration to Indus International University from UGC/AIU approved universities shall only be considered before the commencement of third semester
- Migration from Indus International University shall only be allowed after the completion of first year. Such student has to submit the fee of all the pending semesters of the program.

Minimum Class Strength

- University may withdraw a programme, if the number of students admitted in a program is less than 30% of the total sanctioned in the programme. Students admitted in programmes which have been discontinued due to non-conformation of minimum number of class strength, will be required to exercise programme-change option. In such cases the student will have to pay additional fee, for a higher fee programme. For a lower fee programme, the additional fee charged, if any, shall be adjusted in next semester fee.
- If the programme-change option is not agreed upon, then the tuition fee submitted by student shall be refunded.

Caution Deposit

Each course has a caution deposit which is refundable, subject to deduction due to fine of any nature viz. breakage or loss of any university property including library, laboratory etc. A general breakage fee may be levied when the damage is general and a group of students are involved. In addition, Rs 500/- towards convocation fee and Rs. 500/- towards Alumni Association, will be deducted.



Admission Withdrawal Policy (Refer to UGC E.No. 1-3/2007 (CPP-II) dated 23/03/07)

- A student has to apply for refund and withdrawal of admission specifying the circumstances thereto.
- The Tuition Fee shall be refunded as per guidelines issued by UGC from time to time.

There are two hostels, one each for boys and girls. Boys' hostel is located beside the university campus while the Girls' hostel is at Naya Nangal. Both the hostels are equipped with bed, study table, and storage facility. Rooms in the hostel are available on solo or sharing basis. Excellent catering facility is provided to within the hostel for breakfast, lunch, evening tea and dinner, all days of the week. The menu changes daily to cater to all tastes. Each hostel also has a common room, TV and indoor games facility. Governance of the hostel is by a warden assisted by housekeeping and security staff.

Healthcare

Medical staff is always available in the IIU campus during the working hours for primary and emergency health care of the students and staff. For advanced healthcare, MOU has been signed with a well-equipped and managed ultra modern hospital, available at one km away from the campus.

Transport

IIU has fleet of 12 new and cosy star buses to provide transport facility. These buses ply up to various destinations located at about 80 km in Himachal Pradesh and 100 km in Punjab.Rs.750 as administrative charges will be applicable to all students.



University Examination Policy

All UG and PG programmes follow a semester system where each semester have minimum ninety instructional days as per UGC guidelines. The FALL semester starts in August while the SPRING in January and ends with examination schedule. Examination Committee under the able leadership of (COE) determines the policies, procedure and schedules which Dr. Manish Taunk are embodied in the academic calendar. Each course has a well-defined syllabus with specified number of credit hours for theory and practical classes. The degree is awarded under course credit system.

Continuous evaluation is the focus for the assessment of students and evaluation is done for every theory and practical (where applicable) course. This is achieved through quizzes, assignments, presentations, projects, mid-semester test and final semester test for each student. As per UGC guidelines 75% attendance in lecture classes in every course is must for appearing in the final semester test. As per academic regulations of IIU, the following marks will be awarded for attendance: 95% and above: 10Marks, 90-94%: 8Marks, 85-89%: 6Marks, 80-84%: 4Marks and 75-79%: 2Marks. The student's performance in each theory course is evaluated for a maximum of 100 Marks of which 30 marks are for in-semester assessment, 10 marks for attendance and 60 marks are for the mid and end semester examinations. Absolute marks are awarded for all tests, quizzes, assignments and laboratory work evaluations. It is also mandatory to secure 30% marks in theory examinations (MST+FST) of a course to pass. Based on the performance of a student, each student is awarded a letter grade in each subject at the end of semester. The following letter grades are broad indicators of the UG grading policy, for the accumulated weighted marks for a particular course, in an entire semester.

Letter grades A, B, C, D are pass grades and F grade is the fail grade. A student is declared pass only if he/she secures the minimum required grade points in each course. If a student fails in any subject he/she will directly go to backlog examination after proper application for the same. All academic activities including attendance to results of all examinations can be viewed on ERPby students using their login Ids provided by examination cell. The university follows zero tolerance for malpractice in examinations and there is strict provision of penalty.

Faculty-Advisor Initiative

The University has a very successful faculty-advisor scheme of fostering the culture of strong bonding between students and academia. Students in the University are divided into small groups and each group is looked after by a faculty member. Faculty members remain in regular contact with the parents and discuss the performance of students time to time throughout the academic programme. Students' absence in the classrooms are informed to their parents regularly. The basic aim of the initiative is to provide a holistic environment where prospective engineers, managers and career-oriented students develop as socially responsible human beings.

Training & Placement

IIU has academic arrangements with several multinational companies who have industry accredited offerings for training in soft and domain-specific skills. These, though not part of our regular curriculum, are offered to selected students in addition to their degree programme. Some of the industry accredited programmes like MBA have strong work experience component with a provision for earn-while-learn scheme in place. For engineering programmes, internships with industry is a must in the final year of the course while for MBA programme, it is industry linked from the first semester itself. The cell provides the following facilities to its registered students: a) Industry and Career Orientation programmes, b) Soft skill and personality development workshops, c) Mock written Tests for IT industries, d) Mock Interview and Group Discussion, e) Invited Talk by Experts from Industry, Academia and regulatory bodies, f) Industry Visits, g) Industrial Internships, h) Placement opportunities in On-Campus and Off-Campus drives. All the students of IIU need to get themselves registered with Training and Placement Cell of IIU by filling the online registration form. Placement assistance is provided only to all those registered under the placement cell. T & P cell provides and ensures 100% placement assistance for all the eligible graduates of IIU. Ultimate selection of the student though depends on the performance of the student in the interview, meeting the eligibility criteria and industry specific needs & parameters. Anti-Ragging Measures

Ragging is strictly prohibited in IIU and its hostels. We provide a fostering environment for a strong vibrant and warm relationship amongst the senior and junior students. Any interactive session between senior and junior students shall be conducted in the presence of teachers. Any interaction that causes discomfort may invite punishment that may take any of the following forms as decided by the Anti-Ragging Committee, depending upon the severity of offence:

- Suspension from classes/hostel or Expulsion from the university
- Debarring from appearing in university examination
- · Rustication from the university for a period up to two years
- Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-
- · Rigorous imprisonment up to three years through the process of court of law.

Student Conduct and Discipline Rules

The behavior of the vast majority of IIU students is exemplary - they are responsible and considerate. To deal with those who are not, the University has a disciplinary system whose purpose is to protect the University community and to deter those who interfere with its work and activities. Students agree to abide by the University rules at the time they register and these applynot just on campus but outside of campus as well. Parents, staff and students all expect IIU to maintain a safe, orderly and peaceful environment we at IIU take this very seriously. We at IIU believe that it is important to encourage and reinforce positive behavioural patterns. Observance of the college rules and regulations is compulsory. The students who violate any of the University rules and regulations shall have to bear the consequences that come under various categories of offences. The details of general code of conduct, student grievances, various categories of offences and penalties thereof are available on university website.

Faculty Resources

An institution is better judged for its quality by its faculty resource. The major strength of IIU lies in its team of faculty members which has a combination of both youth & experience. Some faculty members have Ph.Ds, rest of them possess postgraduate degrees. Many of the faculty members of the institute are life members of the various professional bodies and are the reviewers of international journals. Apart from performing formal instructions in the classrooms, tutorial classes and laboratories, the faculty members provide counselling & guidance to students. Individual attention to student is ensured through faculty-advisor scheme for proper personality development of individual & achievement of academic excellence. Faculty members are deputed to attend refreshers courses, short term training programmes and industrial training in order to upgrade their knowledge base. They are also liberally sponsored to attend seminars/workshops/conferences etc. The institute periodically invites visiting faculty from reputable institutions / Universities like NITs/IITs and industry for guest lecturers to provide exposure and varying perspectives to the students.



Sports

Life at IIUis sportive in nature, so is its student and academic community. Indoor sports arena provides facilities for badminton, table tennis and other such games while the well maintained and large outdoor playground provides opportunities for playing and hosting competitions and tournaments like basket ball, football and cricket. Students make use of the available facility during their leisure time and sports festivals. Some of our students are state level players in various sports and games. Inter-departmental, Staff-Student and inter-institutional sports competitions are held during the weekends.

Library



Ground floor of the Main Block houses the spacious Central Library and the adjoining Reading room. The library follows an open access system and fully automated with respect to functionalities like issue, return, search of books and journals. It has more than 15,000 books in its collection covering all the courses being offered presently. IIU follows a policy of continuous acquisition and in the process of building a larger collection vast collection of e-books, digital course ware prepared by of text and reference books. In addition, the library 24 has a various faculty members.

It also subscribes to relevant print and e-journals and magazines. The library is a member of the National Digital Library IIT-KGP. The digital library section has 10 systems though access can be made from any where in the campus as the entire campus is Wi-Fi enabled. Aqualified librarian supervises the library activities and issues books to the students under college rules.

Cafeteria

The campus houses a spacious Cafeteria with well- equipped and hygienic kitchen. It has a favorite chill out zone for students and staff alike. Breakfast, lunch are available at affordable price.

Extra-curricular Activities

At IIU, students work, play, innovate and rejoice hard. All extra and co-curricular activities are organised under various Clubs like STEPUP, Robotics, Programming, Music & Dance and Literary at the University. IIUprides itself in having a student driven culture on campus. Students are exposed to real life experiences when they design and create models, robots etc. and manage various clubs and cells. They organize Technical festivals, Cultural festivals, Study tours, Industrial visits etc. They also arrange competitions like drama, creative writing, debates, dancing, sketching, clay modeling, computer programming, machine-designing to sports like cricket, football, volleyball, badminton and table tennis.




