# About Ranchi

Earlier the name of Ranchi District was Lohardaga. The old district had come into existence after the creation of the non-regulation South - West frontier as a result of the Kol rising in 1831-32. The name of the district was changed in 1899 from Lohardaga to Ranchi after the name of a small village now comprised within the headquarters station.

In ancient times the tract which corresponds to the district of Ranchi and the neighouring parganas was in the undisturbed possession of Munda and Oraon Tribes and was known to Aryans as Jharkhand or the Yorest territory'. The entire tract was presumably beyond the pale of the direct Hindu influence in ancient India. However, Jarasandh, the mighty emperor of Rajgriha in the Mahabharat period might have exercised some kind of loose supervision over the area. Similarly, Magapadmand Agrasen of Magadh, who subdued the entire country upto Orissa, might have gained some control over Jharkhand as well. Geography

Ranchi is located on the southern part of the Chota Nagpur plateau which forms the eastern edge of the Deccan plateau. Ranchi is referred to as the "City of Waterfalls", due to the presence of numerous large and small falls around the close vicinity of the city. The most popular ones are Dassam Falls, Hundru Falls, Jonha Falls, Hirni Falls and Panchghagh Falls. The Subarnarekha river and its tributaries constitute the local river system. Dams in Kanke, Rukka and Hatia have been built over these channels to cater to the water requirements of majority the population. Ranchi has a hilly topography and its combination with dense tropical forests ensures that it enjoys a comparatively moderate climate compared to the rest of the state. Previously, it was accorded a hill station status during the British rule. Rapid population growth and industrialization have caused considerable change in the weather pattern and rise in average temperatures. This has resulted in gradual loss of this "Hill Station" like status.

Ranchi has a humid subtropical climate. However, due to its position and the forests around the city, it is known for its pleasant climate. Its climate is the primary reason why Ranchi was once the summer capital of the undivided State of Bihar. Temperature ranges from maximum 42 to 20 °C during summer, and from 25 to 0 °C during winter .December and January are the coolest months with temperature getting to freezing point in some places of the city. The annual rainfall is about 1430 mm (56.34 inches). From June to September the rainfall is about 1,100 mm. Waterfalls-Ranchi

- Hundru Fall: one of the most picturesque falls surrounding Ranchi. It is 45 kms from Ranchi on Ranchi-Purulia Road.. Here, the Subarnarekha river falls from a height of 320 feet. The pools at the bottom of the falls are favourite picnic and bathing spots.
- Jonha Fall: also known as Gautamdhara is around 40 Kms from Ranchi. It is approachable by both Road and train. The fall can be admired by descending around 500 steps. There is a tourist rest house which contains Lord Buddha temple. The river Kanchi flows nearby.
- Dassam falls: is 34 kms from Ranchi on Ranchi-Tata Road near a village called Taimara. Here, the Kachni river falls from an altitude of 144 feet. It is also known as Dassam Gagh.
- Panch Gagh fall: is on Ranchi- Chakradharpur Road about 6 kms from Khunti. This fall consists of five streams formed in a row due to the breaking up of the Banai river which falls from a good height. Cemented walkways connect the different cataracts, of which stream 2 is the most popular while 5 is
- the biggest, though a bit inaccessible.

  Hirni falls: Another beautiful waterfall amidst forests about 70 km from Ranchi.
- Sita Fall: Adjacent to Jonha falls is Sita falls which can be seen at its best early in the morning.

#### Religious Places-Ranchi

- Ranchi Hill and Pahari Mandir: is one of the landmark of Ranchi Town. The Shiva temple is situated on the top of the hill also known as Pahari Mandir. At the bottom of the hill is Ranchi Lake, Ranchi lake was excavated by Colonel Onsely in 1842.
- Jagannathpur Temple: is 10 km apart from Ranchi town Jagannathpur temple was built in 1691 having resemblance with architectural style of Puri temple. Thakur Ani Nath Shahdeo, of Barkagarh Jagannathpur built the temple. Rath yatra similar to Puri is held every year.
- Sun Temple: is situated at a distance of 40 kms on Ranchi Tata Road. It is built in the form of a Charlot with 18 wheels drawn by 7 white horses. It is surrounded by a pond which is used by devotees during Chhath Puja for worshipping of Sun.

  Angrabari (Amreshwar Dham): is a temple consisting of the deity of Lord Shiva, Ram and Sita, Hanuman and Ganesh. It is situated near Khunti at a
- distance of about 40 kms from Ranchi. The Shankracharya Swami Swarupanand Saraswati, having been captivated by serene, placid and celestial
- beauty of Angrabadi rechristened it as Amreshwar Dham.

  Devri Temple: A temple of Solha Bhuji Goddess Durga, is located on right side of Ranchi-Tata highway(NH33) at 60 kms from Ranchi. It is the only temple in Jharkhand where the religious rituals are performed by the Pahans(tribal priests) along with conventional Brahmins.
- GEL Church: Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur , Assam in short G.E.L. Church started on 2nd November 1845 by four German Missionaries named Emil Schatz, Fredrik batsch, Augustus Brandt and E. Theodor Janke sent by Fr. Johaness Evangelista Gossner of Berlin. They arrived Ranchi and erected their tents and G.E.L. Church was inaugurated with church service on 2nd November 1845.

- Other Interesting Places-Ranchi

  Gonda Hill and Rock Garden: is situated at a distance of about 4 kms from Ranchi town on Ranchi Kanke Road. Rock Garden is carved out of the rocks of Gonda Hill and resembles its design to rock garden of Jaipur. At the base of the Hill is Kanke Dam.
  - Tagore Hill: The Morhabadi Hill famous as Tagore Hill is an important tourist spot. The elder brother of Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore, Jyotirindranath Tagore has built a house (Shantidham) on the the hill. It is known as Tagore Hill due to its association with tagore family. Rath yatra similar to Puri is held every year.
  - Nakshatra Van: is situated in the heart of the City. It is divided into various sections. There is a big circle in the center of the park which is divided into arcs. The tree that represents the particular nakshatras in the zodiac has been planted in each of the corresponding arcs.
  - Muta Crocodile breeding centre: is situated at a distance of 23 km from Ranchi on Ranchi Ramgarh Road near Ormanjhi. There are around 50 crocodiles.
  - Birsa Jaivik Udyan: is situated at a distance of 16 km from Ranchi in Ranchi Ramgarh Road near Ormanjhi. Many species of animals, trees and plants can be seen here
  - Ranchi Lake: Located at the base of Ranchi Hills is excayted in the year 1842.
  - Mc Cluskigunj: It is famous for European style bungalows and a tribal museum
  - Tribal Research Institute and Museum: Located in Morhabadi. It shows tribal culture of Chotanagpur plateau.

#### B.Ed.-M.Ed.

#### (Integrated)

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The Integrated B.Ed. - M.Ed. Programme is a three-year full-time professional programme in education, without any option of intermediate exist before completing the 3 years of study. It aims at preparing teacher educators and other professionals in education, including curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, educational planners and administrators, school principals, supervisors, and researchers in the field of education. The completion of the programme shall lead to integrated B.Ed. M.Ed. degree with specialisation in either elementry education (upto class VIII) or secondary and senior secondary education (VI to XII).

#### Duration: 3 Years

#### Eligibility:

Candidates seeking admission to the Inegrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. programme should have the following qualifications:

Essential a Postgraduate degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities from a recognised institution with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade.

Desirable: It as desirable that the candidates have a demonstrated interest and experience in education.

#### Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the University. Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government/University whichever is applicable.

#### M.Ed.

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) Programme is a two-year professional programme in the field of Teacher Education which aims at preparing teacher educators and other education professional including curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, planners, administrators, supervisors, school principals and researchers. The completion of the programme shall lead to M.Ed. degree with specialisation either in elementary education (upto class VIII) or in secondary education (classes VI-XII).

#### Duration: 2 Years

#### Eligibility:

Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade in the following programmes:

- (1) B.Ed.
- (2) B.A., B.Ed., B.Sc., B.Ed.
- (3) B.E.Ed.
- (4) D.E.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each).

Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the Central / State Government / University whichever is applicable.

#### Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and/or in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the University.

#### B.Ed.

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The Bachelor of Education programme, generally known as B.Ed., is a professional course that prepares teachers for upper primary or middle level (classes VI-VIII), secondary level (classes IX-X) and senior secondary level (classes XI-XII).

#### Duration: 2 Years

#### Eligibility:

- (a) Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.
- (b) The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central /State Government/University, whenever is applicable.

#### Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and/or in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the University.

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The four-year integrated programme aims at integrating general studies comprising science (B.Sc.B.Ed.) and social sciences or humanities (B.A. B.Ed.) and professional studies comprising foundation of education, pediagogy of school subjects, and practicum related to the tasks and functions of a school teacher. It maintains a balance between theory and practice, and coherence and integration among the components of the programme, representing a wide knowledge base of a secondary school teacher. The programme aims at preparing teacher for Upper Primary and Secondary stages of education.

#### **Duration:** 5 Years

#### Eligibility:

- (a) Candidates with at least 50% marks in the senior secondary/+2 or its equivalent are eligible for admission.
- (b) The reservation and relaxation in marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other category shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government/University whichever is applicable.

#### Admission Procedure:

- (a) Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the State Government.
- (b) At the time of admission to the programme the student will need to indicate their selection of the subjects to be pursued for the discipline options and the accompanying pedagogic specializations for which they are applying and these may be assigned on the basis of order of merit and availability.

#### B.P.Ed.

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) programme is a professional programme meant for preparing teachers for physical education in classes VI-X and for conducting physical education and sports activities in classes XI-XII.

#### Duration: 2 Years

#### Eligibility:

(i) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter College/ Inter-Zonal / District / School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

Or

- (ii) Bachelor's degree in physical education with 45% marks. Or Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied physical education as compulsory elective subject.
- (iii) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National / Inter University / State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College / Inter-Zonal / District / School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India. Or
- (iv) Bachelor's degree with participation in International competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National / Inter University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations / AIU / IOA / SGFI / Govt. of India.
  Or
- (v) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers / coaches).
   The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central / State Government /

#### Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance examination (written test, sports proficiency test, physical fitness test and marks obtained in the qualifying examination) or any other selection process as per the policy of the University.

#### D.P.Ed.

#### Recognized by NCTE, New Delhi

The Diploma in Physical Education (D.P.Ed.) programme is a professional programme meant for preparing physical education teachers for elementary stage of school education (Class I to VIII).

#### <u>Duration</u>: 2 Years Eligibility:

Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with at least 50% marks. However, 5% relaxation will be given to those who have participated in International / National / SGFI Sports Competition.

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central / State Government/University. whichever is applicable.

#### Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit, on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance examination (written test, sports proficiency test, physical fitness test and marks obtained in the qualifying examination) or any other selection process as per the policy of the University.

# **Diploma Engineering**

**Duration:** 4 Years

Eligibility:

Candidate for admission to the M. Tech. degree programmes should have passed the final examination of the 4-years (or 8-semester) B.E. or B.Tech. degree programme of an appropriate branch of Engineering/Technology or M.Sc in appropriate subject.

Duration: 2 Years

- The processing fee with duly filled up application form is to be submitted with the hard copy of application form on or before the furnished last date.
- 4. The application form should be submitted alongwith
  - Attested Copy of the mark sheet of the qualifying examination. (Three Sets)
  - Attested Copy of the mark sheet of the High School examination/Intermediate/Graduation (As the case may be).
  - Transfer certificate (T.C.) (Original).
  - Certificate of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes if applicable.
  - Character Certificate (Original).
  - Five Passport size photographs with three self addressed envelops affixed with 25/- Rs. postal stamps individually.
  - Any fee once paid to university during the admission or afterwards will not be refunded under any circumstances.
  - If any important information or misguiding document or intimation is produced by candidate then the Competent Authority is empowered to cancel the admission and university has right to reject the admission of any candidate without assigning any notice.
- 5. In case of any disputes difference / claim and or grievance arising in connection with any matter regarding functioning of the university amongst students / any member of staff / any outside person or authority having any dealing with the university, the same shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Chancellor of the university. Decision of arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the parties. No person / authority shall have a right to take any matter to a civil court / any other tribunal without first resorting to arbitration.
