The Khadki and Pune railway stations are just 2km and 9km respectively away and the Pune International airport is 15 km from the university campus. Mumbai, Maharashtra's capital city, is 150 km away from Pune and is well connected to Pune by rail, road and air. Geographically, the university is bordered by Mulla river in the north, Pune University in the south, the Government Botanical Gardens in the east and Aundh suburb in the west.
